You might feel anxious, worried, or envious. It is about expectations of self, or perhaps of others of you. Never compare.



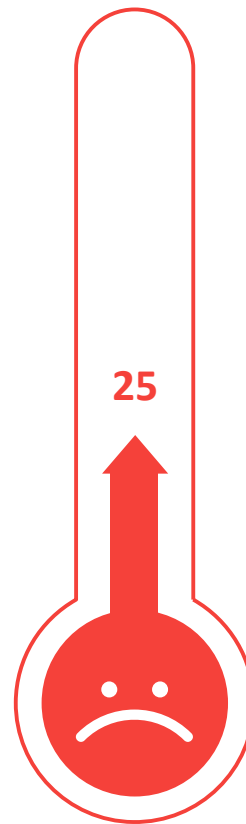
## Neutral Emotions

You might feel neither elated nor sad; you might even feel indifferent. It is ok.

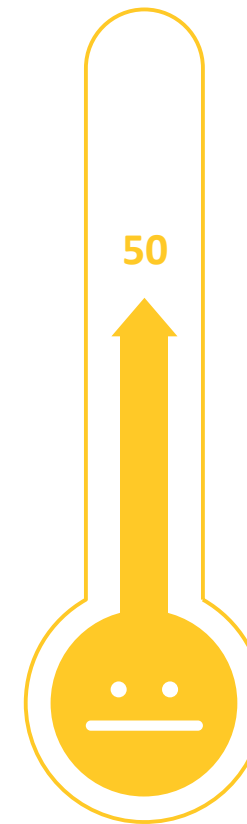


## Positive Emotions

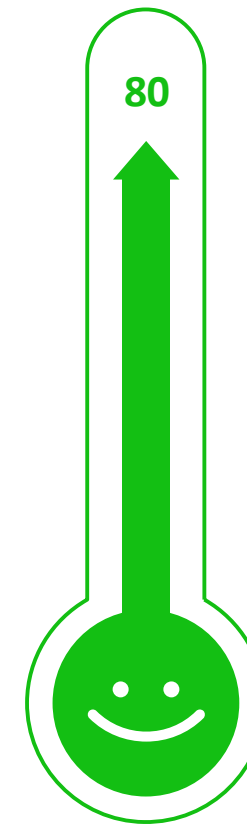
You might feel overjoyed, euphoric. It is again about expectations – you might have exceeded your own, or that of others of you. Again, never compare.

# Regulating Emotions

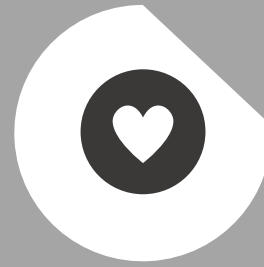
How you could help yourself, not just now, but in future situations as well



## SPOT

Recognise your emotion

Be aware of how you are feeling. If you have a negative sentiment, become aware of it. Label that emotion. Are you feeling angry? Are you feeling dejected?



## STOP

Hold the emotion

Stop what is causing that emotion. If it is your results, remove yourself from the situation, inhale deeply and exhale slowly using counts of 10, and seek the help of an adult.



## SWAP

Change the emotion

Know that what caused the emotion is not permanent and is not a measure of other aspects of your life. It does not define who you are as a person. There *are* many good choices to consider. Speak to a trusted adult or friend.

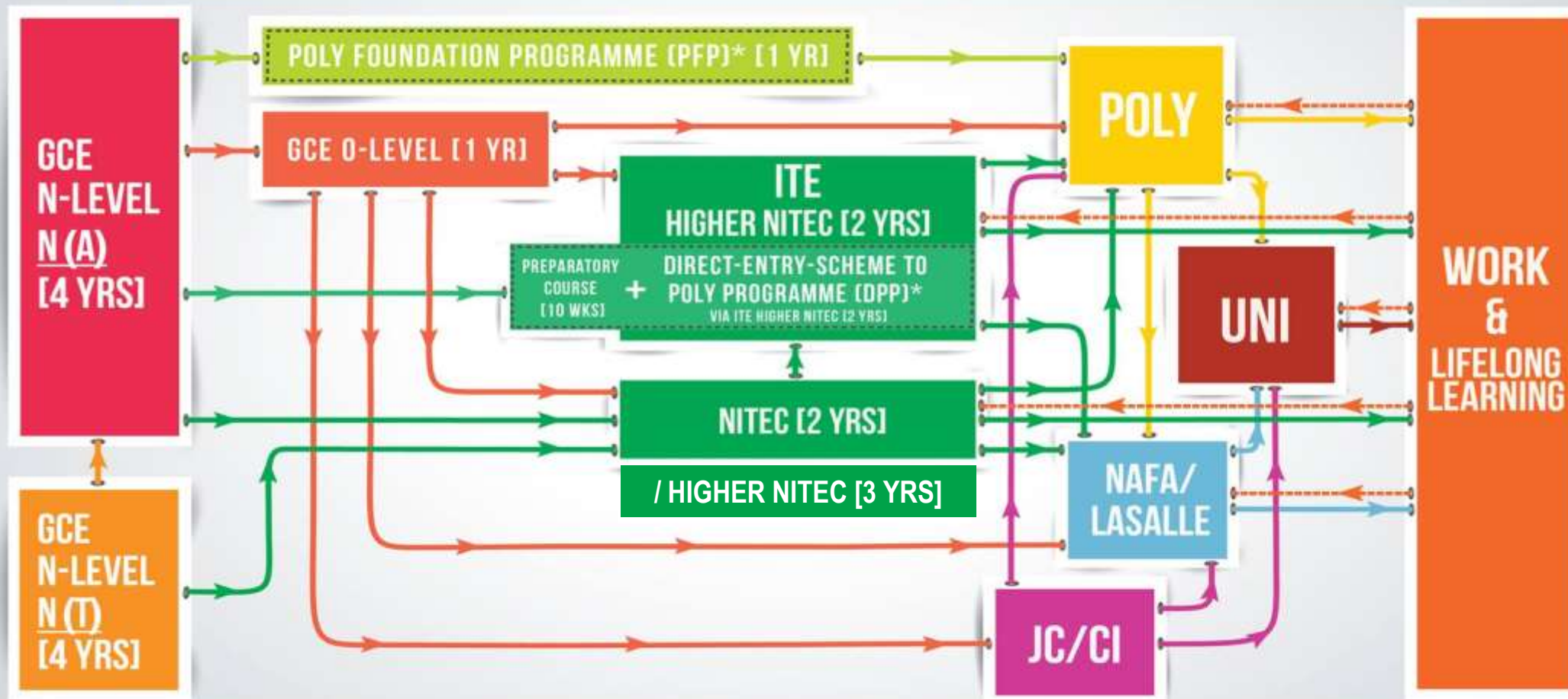

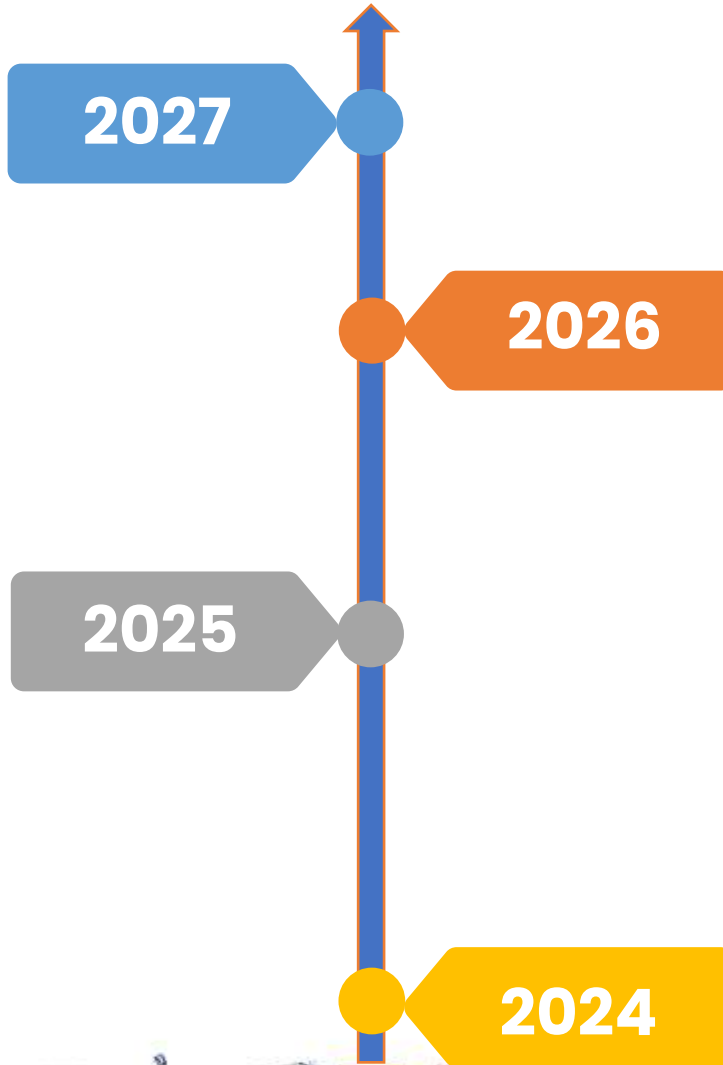

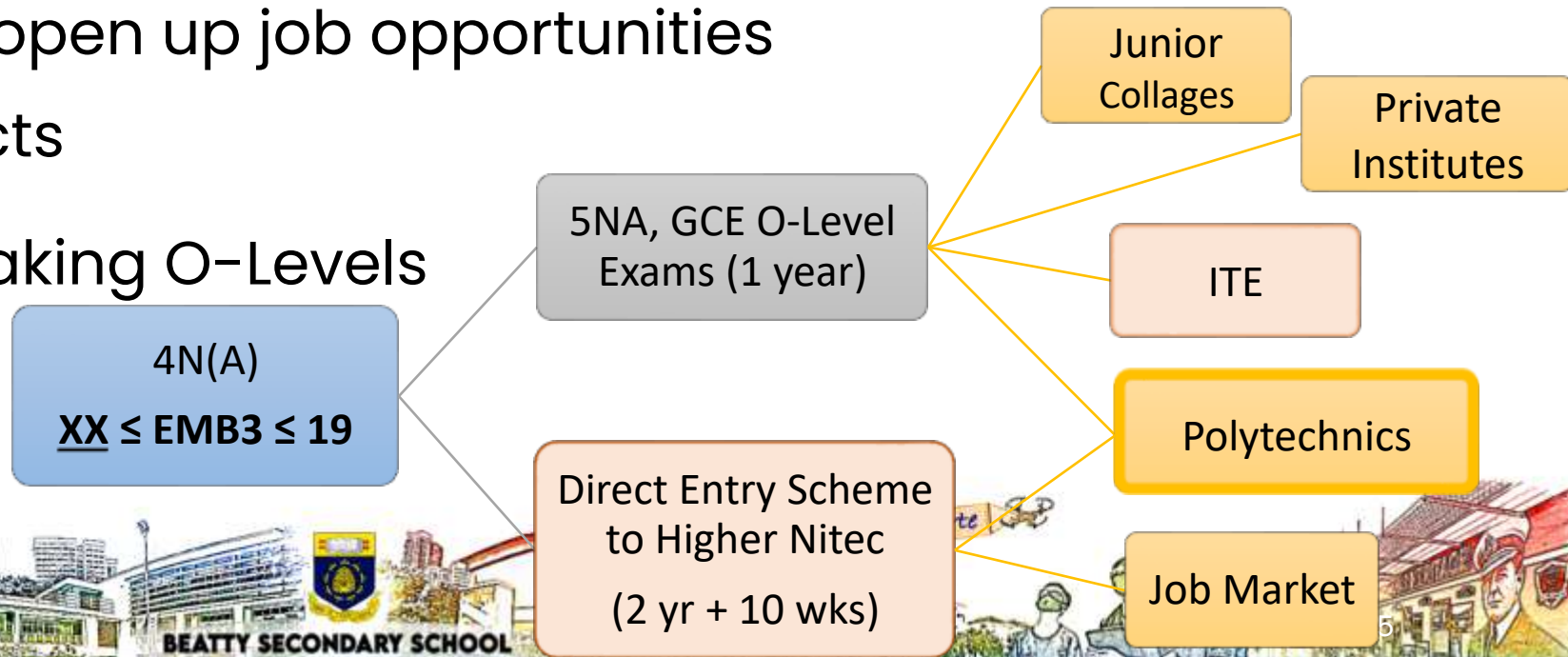




# DPP: JIE-H

## Sec 4N(A) Direct Entry to Higher Nitec Courses AT ITE [DPP]

- **Why Higher Nitec and not Sec 5?**
- Hands on learning, practice-oriented learning approach
- 70% practical training + 30% theory lessons
- Technical skills acquired open up job opportunities and good career prospects
- Skips the **uncertainty** of taking O-Levels

- Online Application: **Mon, 18 Dec 2:30 pm** to **Thur, 21 Dec 5:00 pm**

- DPP posting results will be released on: **Fri, 22 Dec from 2:00 pm** onwards
- Students who receive a DPP offer are required to accept or reject the offer between: **22 Dec to 27 Dec 2023**
  - Appeal: **22 Dec to 27 Dec 2023**
  - Release of Appeal Results: **29 Dec 2023 (from 9am)**
- Report to ITE: **8 Jan 2024**
- Students who do not get a confirmed DPP place **must** report to Beatty Secondary for Sec 5 on **2 Jan 2024**

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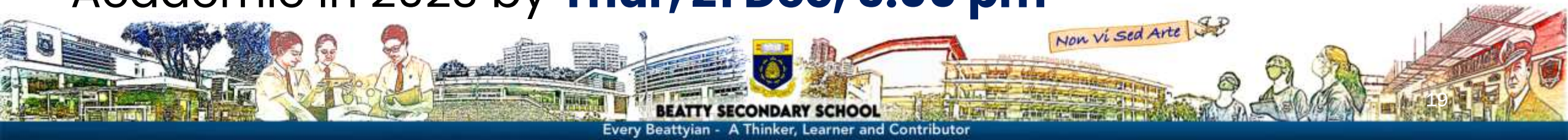
# Application for PFP

- Students who are interested in applying to the PFP should first progress to **Secondary 5. Term starts on 2 Jan 2024.**
- Upon the release of the 2023 GCE O-Level results in January 2024, **eligible N(A) students will receive a copy of Form P** through the school, inviting them to apply for the Polytechnic Diploma courses of their choice under the PFP.
- Applications for the PFP will commence after the release of the GCE O-Level results.
- Application results will be released by end-January 2024. **Students should withdraw from Secondary 5 only after they have accepted a PFP offer** (26 Jan 2024).

# Moving on to Sec 5 N(A)

## • Criteria

- ELMAB3  $\leq$  19  
(EL, MA and best three other subjects, aggregate score of 19 points or less)
- All subjects used in the computation of your ELMAB3 aggregate must each be **an N-Level grade 5 or better**
- Collect the application form from the General Office
- Complete and submit Application form for Secondary 5 Normal Academic in 2023 by **Thur, 21 Dec, 5:00 pm**



# Taking the GCE O-Level

- Students with higher (poorer) ELMAB3 in N Levels tend also to achieve higher (poorer) LIB4 at the O-Levels.
- **2 in 3** students who achieved **ELMAB3  $\geq$  17** failed to achieve LIB4  $\leq$  26 to qualify for poly.
- There are of course exceptions.
- **Attitude is key.**
- **Make your choices wisely.**





# How can I enter a Polytechnic?

- ELR2B2 is used for Poly admissions
  - English Language
  - 2 Relevant Subjects (course dependent)
  - 2 Other Best Subjects
- You must also meet the pre-requisites or minimum entry requirements for specific courses
  - For example, a minimum of A2 in English Language
- Refer to JAE booklet for details of admission criteria
  - check online or enquire at the General Office

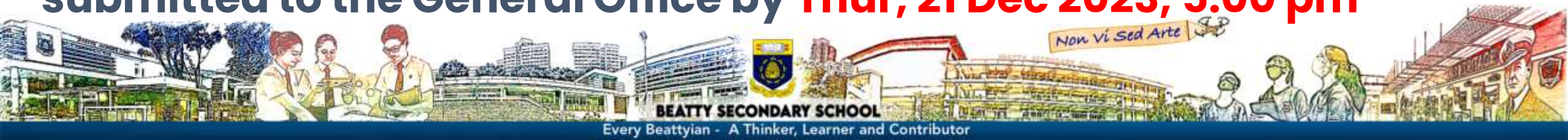


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# Repeating Sec 4N(A)

- Applicants, **together with their parents**, must **meet P** before re-admission to 4N(A).
- Students must **complete Application to repeat Secondary 4 Normal Academic in 2024**.
- Application to repeat Secondary 4 Normal Academic in 2023 **must be submitted to the General Office by **Thur, 21 Dec 2023, 5:00 pm****



1. All N(A)\* / N(T) school leavers are encouraged to put in an application during the **1<sup>st</sup> Phase (Main Phase)** between **18 Dec 2023 (2.30pm) to 21 Dec 2023 (5pm)**. Application results for the 1<sup>st</sup> Phase will be released on **29 Dec 2023 at 9am**.
2. If you wish to appeal, please accept the course offered **before** applying in the **2<sup>nd</sup> Phase (Late Application/Appeal Phase)** between **29 Dec 2023 to 3 Jan 2024**. The application results for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase will be known on **10 Jan 2024 at 9am**.
3. Unsuccessful applicants can appeal under the **3<sup>rd</sup> Phase (Final Top-up Phase)** between **10 Jan to 18 Jan 2024 and 24 Jan to 7 Feb 2024** for courses with vacancies. The application results for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Phase will be known between **15 Jan to 24 Jan 2024** and **24 Jan to 14 Feb 2024**.

# Certificate Amendments

- Students are to check that their names (such as statutory names and Hanyu Pinyin names) are printed correctly on their result slips as the same names will be printed on their certificates.
- Students with changes in names are to inform staff at the General Office **by 4:00 pm today**. An administrative fee may be imposed.





# Appeal for Review of Results

- Students can approach staff at General Office for the application form.
- Appeal fee is \$112.35 (SC), \$113.40 (SPR) or \$113.40 (IS) per subject.
- The **deadline**\* for the application for appeal of results and the payment of appeal fees is **Fri, 22 Dec 2023**.
- Outcome is expected to be released by Fri, 2 Feb 2024 (no report of performance will be provided)

*\*No further application will be considered by SEAB after the appeal deadline*



# Repeating 4N(A) in 2024

- Students eligible for **JIE-E** are encouraged to apply for an available course at ITE.
- Students whose promotion status is “Repeat” need to see Mr Lee Chau Loong and/or Ms Marhainy.
- The form to repeat 4N(A) must be submitted by **Thur, 21 Dec 2023, 5pm**.
- Applicants, together with their parents, must be met by P before re-admission to 4N(A).
